He named his new organization - Webwah's Witnesses, "in order to distinguish it from the various groups formed by the 75% of original Bible Students no longer connected. Hundreds of these Bible Student congregations worldwide have continued to the present, thus constituting a continuation of the original IBSA. These Bible Students remain united in the original early Watchtower beliefs taught by Pastor Russell.

The Watchtower has a circulation of over 42 million in more than 190 languages.




A close second is Awake! with a circulation of 41 million in more than 80 languages.




In 1917, Joseph Franklin Rutherford became the second President of the Watchtower Society.




In 1975, Nathan Knorr became the third President of the Watchtower Society.




In 1977 Frederick W. Franz took over the presidency upon the death of Nathan Knorr.







In 2000 Don Adams took over the presidency upon the resignation of Milton G. Henschel.




In 2012 Robert Ciranko took over the presidency upon the resignation of Don Adams.

















Thus, there is a distinction between the Watchtower as a non-profit organization and the governing body.

The local congregation, called the "Kingdom Hall," is guided by unpaid male elders who arrange meetings, teaching times, speakers, and more.



There are 9,043,460 Jehovah's Witnesses (up from 8,816,562) worshiping in 118,767 (up from 118,117) in 240 different lands (up from 239) conducting 7,480,146 (up from 7,281,212) free home Bible courses conducted.
